Special thanks go to everybody who helped organise the match and all the players.

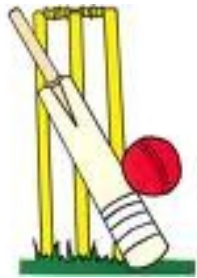
## Yorkshire League Cup
